



Create Animal IDs using 4-H Online

- Login to <http://idaho.4honline.com> using your established family email and password
- Click on “orange button” to continue to family
- Select youth member who you will be adding animals for – click edit
- (on top of page) select Animals/Livestock
- Select animal species from list and click “add animal” button
- Fill out all animal information (those boxes with bold text must be completed)
- Upload pictures or other related documents related to animal
- Click “Save” (you can go back later and edit if needed)
- Repeat as needed for multiple animals or members

Who: All non-market (pet, breeding, dairy, etc.) Beef, Dog, Goat, Horse, Sheep and Swine projects

Why: to establish ownership of all non-market 4-H animals

How: using 4-H Online or pervious paper version

When: Horse and Dog due April 1, All others due June 1

What if..: All non-market animals going to fair need an ID sheet on file to be fully eligible to compete in classes. We recommend that members keep an ID sheet on any animal they might use during the 4-H year.

Market animals are not required to have an ID sheet because we tag and photograph all of them at the spring weigh ins. If a member would like to do an electronic ID sheet on a market animal they can, but it will only be for their records.

Additional stuff: For this year we will handle all additional animal related forms in the traditional paper manner. This includes Quality Assurance forms and brand inspection paperwork.
