What is a Model Horse Show?

- A model horse show is like a regular horse show, but for model horses, such as Breyers.
- Horses are to be entered in classes based on size, action, and theme.
- Horses will be judged by condition, conformation, and quality.

*NOTE: Minimum of 10 exhibitor entries must be received to hold show. Exhibitors must register by deadline. Entries at the door will only be accepted if minimum number of entries have been met.
