#### YOUTH LIVESTOCK 4-H WEIGH-INS

Market animal projects must have their animal (and floater) weighed and tagged at the events below.

Swine: June 9 3:00-8:00pm, Latah County Fairgrounds

Sheep/Goat: July 6 4:00-6:00pm, Latah County Fairgrounds

#### MARKET ANIMAL DOCUMENTS NEEDED:

When purchasing an animal, get a **Bill of Sale** (all species). Forms are available at the Extension Office and on ZSuite. Your Bill of Sale will be **DUE** with your record book on Sunday of Fair. Youth exhibiting home raised animals will need to include the form, as well. This is a STATE 4-H REQUIREMENT.

According to the ISDA, animals being imported from out of state will need a **Certificate of Veterinary Inspection** (CVI; Health Inspection) to cross state lines. Contact info@isda.idaho.gov with any questions.




