Interview Evaluations are scheduled to take place July 26th and July 27th. Please keep an eye on your mail, as we will be sending out your child's scheduled time. If that time does not work for you, please contact us immediately to set up another time!

Interviews are a requirement for your child to finish their project, and help your child learn important life skills. Through interviews, 4-H members are taught how to verbalize their activities and accomplishments, and how these accomplishments have enhanced their attitudes, values and judgements. Just like with a job interview, showing up early, dressed nicely, with their hair combed and teeth brushed, a big smile and a deep breath will help calm those nerves!

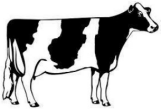


4-H Fun Day!

Attention all 4-H Sheep, Goat, Dairy and Beef projects! Showmanship practices will be starting the second full week of June! Don't forget, **one showmanship practice is required per project member!** Cloverbuds do not have to attend..

- Sheep will be June 13, 27 and July 11 in the Limbaugh Arena starting @ 7 PM
- Goat will be June 13, 27 and July 11 in the Ford Arena starting @ 7 PM
- Chicken & Rabbit will be June 13, 27 and July 11 all beginning at 7 PM
- Dairy will be June 14, 28, and July 12 in the Ford Arena starting @ 7 PM
- Beef will be June 14, 28, and July 12 in the Limbaugh Arena starting @ 7 PM
