Registration will be accepted on a "first come", "first serve basis" with preference to Idaho residence; Any spots not filled by May 5th will be opened to Alpine and Lincoln counties in Wyo. until numbers are reached.

<u>CAMP FEE</u> – **\$70.00** PER PERSON attending camp. Please make checks payable to Alpine 4-H Horse Camp. This fee will be required for <u>EACH AND EVERY</u> person 5 and over years of age who is attending camp regardless of reason for being in camp. <u>No exceptions</u>. (Notice: Camp fees will be increasing to \$75.00 in 2019.)

There will be NO refunds issued unless cancellation in writing is received by June 30, 2018. Extenuating circumstances after June 30th must be presented, in writing, no later than seven days after camp, for consideration by the camp board for refund.

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2018 Camping has changed

Campers will be allowed to ask for a specific camper spot. Anyone with their forms and complete payment submitted by May 5th will be allowed to submit three choices of desired campsite. All efforts will be taken to place you in one of your choices. If there are duplicate requests for same spot when filling camp spots, a drawing of requests will determine who camps there. If unable to honor one of your three choices, placement will be made to the next closest camping spot. If you have oversized campers/horse trailer please note on request. If you are wanting to camp together as a group, please submit your paperwork together at the same time.

You will be able to set up your camping area after noon Monday for a \$20.00 fee. <u>Anyone</u> wanting to come in prior to the normal Tuesday time, but not earlier than Monday noon can enter camp but will need to include \$20.00 with entry forms or prior to June 30th. No one will be allowed into camp on Monday without prior authorization, (will be sent to you upon receipt of payment). \$20.00 payment for early parking <u>can not</u> be made at camp.

<u>STALLS</u>: There are no stalls available at Alpine.

HAY: As we are camping in Wyoming on US Forest Service ground, certified weed free hay has to be used. You are not allowed to bring your own hay unless it is certified. We will have certified weed free hay available for purchase at camp. The price is set on delivery to camp. It varies but usually is around \$10.00 a bale; but the cost varies a little from year to year. Come prepared to pay for hay at check in. These bales are usually on the larger size and will generally feed one horse for the entire camp. Hay pellets are acceptable. We will not be initially bringing in more hay than is ordered. **Make sure you order what hay you will need.**

_____Bales of hay you will need to purchase. (Only count hay you will need for **your** horse. Do not count hay for a family member or friend. They need to order their own hay.)

LODGING: Cabins are available for families or groups. Some choose to bring tents or RV's. Each cabin must have at least one adult present. Sleeping arrangements will be made at check in.

<u>Class Fees:</u> Some craft type classes will require a fee for the projects made or purchased. Costs vary depending on the project but \$ 5 to \$10 per class should be sufficient. This will be paid during class. Please plan on a little cash for these projects but don't send much extra. *2 of 3 pages*

T-SHIRTS: T-shirts will be available for sale during registration. Cost will be approximately \$15, give or take a little. If you want a shirt, please complete the information below.
