## PROJECT CAMPS & DAY CAMPS



We are excited about the Project Camps being offered this year. Please be aware that these camps fill up quickly. If your child is interested please sign them up at your earliest convenience. To participate the youth must be enrolled in 4-H (\$20 enrollment fee)

Due to the high demand-we have limited the initial enrollment to 1<sup>st</sup> time participants per project until May 1<sup>st</sup>. After May 1<sup>st</sup>, camps will be open to enrollment to ALL youth even if they have participated in the project in the past.

June 7-11	10:00-12:00 daily	Baking	\$15.00	Learn how to follow a recipe, measure liquids and solids, why certain ingredients are important like yeast and baking powder. Bake cookies, cake and bread from scratch. Grind your own wheat while learning about the importance of eating healthy.
Jun 7-11	2:00-4:00 daily 	Cake Decorating Level 1	\$15.00	Start your cake decorating kit. Learn decorating techniques including how to frost a cake, basic tips and their uses. Decorate your very own cake
June 21-25	9:00-11:00 am daily	Drones	\$12	Drones are a huge part of our future. Youth will learn about different careers in the drone industry, learn about safety and drone ethics and have lots of time to fly drones and create a video of their drone footage.
June 21-25	1:00-3:00 daily	Rocketry 	\$25.00	Learn about and experiment with different types of propulsion while building rockets. Send a capsule up into space without damaging your precious cargo.
July 6-9	9:00-11:00 am daily (4 days)	Art	\$10.00	Learn about different forms of art, the history of art and create works of art.
July 6-9	1:00-3:00 pm (4 days)	Cake Decorating Level 2	\$20	Build on techniques learned in level one. Frost and Decorate a 2-layer cake, work with fondant.

July 12-14-16	8:00-11 Mon (12th) 8:00-1 Wed (14th) 7:00-5 Fri (16th)	Hiking and Outdoors 	\$30.00	Spend time outdoors on 3 different local hikes. Learn about wild flowers and native plants. Learn about safety while hiking. Learn the importance of preparing before starting a hike and put together a hiking pack.
July 19-23	9:30-11:30 daily	Beginning Sewing	\$20.00	Learn the parts of and how to work a sewing machine, sew straight and curved stitches, and start a sewing kit. Sew pajama pants.
July 19-23	1:30 - 3:30 daily 	Level 2 Sewing	\$10.00	Level 2 sewing class is for those that participated in the sewing camp last year or have a little experience in sewing. We will be sewing a project that incorporates skills learned last year and adding new concepts. (participant will provide own fabric)
August 2-6	10:00-11:30 daily	Macrame  <b>Age limit 10+</b>	\$10.00	Learn the art of tying knots to create a work of art. Projects will range from a key chain to a plant hanger or wall hanging.

## SHOOTING SPORTS CAMPS

Our 4-H shooting sports programs are taught by certified shooting sports instructors. Learn range safety, shooting etiquette, and proper shooting techniques while having fun with other youth in a fun and educational environment. Archery Camp will be held in the indoor arena at the Madison County Fair Grounds. The Rifle Camp will be held West of Rexburg at the public Shooting Range.

How it works...you must pre-register and pay the class fees to participate in the camp. Registration is at the Madison county Extension Office and will go until July 10, 2021. For safety reasons, these camps are limited numbers and will fill up fast.

If you are not currently registered in 4-H, you are welcome to join us, but must pay the 4-H dues of \$20, plus the camp fees in which you would like to participate.

Youth who are 8-18 years of age by January 1, 2021, are eligible to participate (no exceptions). Parents are responsible for transportation to and from classes.
