## Guidelines Family & Consumer Sciences: Clothing Achievement Award

- 1. 4-H'ers must be currently enrolled in their 5<sup>th</sup> year (or more) of a constructed clothing project.
- 2. 4-H'ers must at least be entering their sophomore year of High School.
- 3. 4-H'er must not have won this award previously.
- 4. 4-H'er must have completed entry form submitted to Nez Perce County Extension Office by October 1.
- 5. 4-H constructed clothing project must have received a blue ribbon during the year of application.
- 6. Individuals selecting the winner will not have judged the clothing construction projects in the year of application.
- 7. Judging will be based on the following; the learning process, experiences, skills mastered, and how each project showed creativity in construction in the 5 years highlighted on this application.
- 8. Winner will receive a sewing machine.
- 9. If less than 3 applications are received, there may be no award presented for that given year.
