



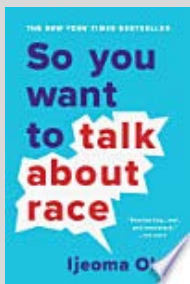
# LEARNING THROUGH DIALOGUE: Fostering Inclusion within CALS
