

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES FOR CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

If you intend to enroll in classes at the University of Idaho or Lewis Clark State College **and** North Idaho College during the same semester, your financial aid enrollment status will be determined by combining credits from both institutions. Your financial aid eligibility will be determined by the Financial Aid Office at the University of Idaho or Lewis-Clark State College.

Step 1

Take your completed Concurrent Enrollment Certification form to the Registrar's Office at North Idaho College. Once you have registered for classes at North Idaho College, the Registrar's Office will then verify your enrollment and submit your form to either University of Idaho or Lewis-Clark State College.

Step 2

If you would like to register for North Idaho College classes and have your tuition and fees postponed until you receive your aid from the University of Idaho or Lewis Clark State College, you must submit a copy of your signed financial aid award letter to the Student Accounts Office at North Idaho College. If your financial aid does not cover the cost of your North Idaho College tuition and fees, you will be responsible for paying the difference at the time of registration.

***** You will be responsible for paying your North Idaho College tuition charges when you receive your aid from the University of Idaho or Lewis Clark State College. If you do not receive financial aid, it is your responsibility to pay all charges owed to North Idaho College. *****
