#### NOTES & REQUIREMENTS

- Students planning on transferring to U of I are advised to complete an A.A. (minimum 60 credits) at NIC.
- Students can be concurrently enrolled while completing an NIC degree.
- Check with U of I advisor for additional coursework options/substitutions.
- A background check, 2.75 GPA, and minimum C grade in ENGL 102, COMM 101, EDUC 201 and a Core Math are required for admission into the U of I teacher education program.

#### NOTES & REQUIREMENTS

- 120 credits are required for a B.S.
- A grade of "C" or above is required for classes in the elementary education program. See advisor for details.
- Students must pass Elementary Education: Content Knowledge, Idaho Comprehensive Literacy Assessment 1 and 2 and single subject endorsement Praxis II exams prior to their internship
