<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students planning on transferring to UI are advised to complete an Associate of Arts degree at NIC - Students can be concurrently enrolled while completing an NIC degree - An A.A. degree is a minimum of 60 credits. - Check with UI advisor for potential substitutions 		
<p>** IMPORTANT **</p> <p>It is very important the student working toward the B.G.S. "look ahead" to see in which departments he or she wishes to accumulate the required 45 credits in upper division courses (300-400 level). Many upper-division courses have prerequisites that must be completed during the early semesters of the student's undergraduate career. If planning is delayed, it may be that some courses will be unavailable because the student has not taken the prerequisites.</p> <p>Students in the General Studies program may transfer to any degree program at any time if they satisfy the GPA and curricular requirements of those programs.</p> <p>To tailor their degree program, a student can complete a minor, certificate, or area of emphasis.</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Complete at least 120 credits - A minimum of 45 credits must be earned in upper division courses (300-400 level) - No more than 36 credits in any one subject can be used towards the degree - 30 of the 120 credits must be upper division from UI
