⁴Six different semesters as follows: **Wind and percussion majors** must register for three different semesters of MusA 119/319 Marching Band and three different semesters of 120/320 Wind Ensemble or MusA 121/321 Concert Band. **Wind and percussion majors** may, by audition, substitute two semesters of MusA 122/322 Orchestra for MusA 120/320 Wind Ensemble or 121/321 Concert Band. **String majors** must register for six different semesters of MusA 122/322 Orchestra and one semester of MusA 119/319 Marching Band. **Keyboard and guitar majors** must enroll in one semester of MusA 119/319 Marching Band. They may substitute one semester of MusA 323 Jazz Band or MusA 365 Jazz Combo, a prereq for MusT 465, for one semester of major instrumental ensemble. They may enroll in major vocal ensembles (MusA 116/316 Vandaleers or MusA 117/317 Men's or Women's Chorus) to satisfy the remaining major ensemble requirements. **Wind, percussion, string and keyboard majors** must have a total of four semesters of major ensemble participation (as defined above) at the University of Idaho.

⁵Two additional semesters chosen from MusA 119/319 Marching Band, 120/320 Wind Ensemble, 121/321 Concert Band, 122/322 Orchestra, 323 Jazz Band, or 365 Chamber Ensemble. Students in the Instrumental Music Education degree who are **keyboard majors** must register for two semesters of MusA 315 Collaborative Piano.

⁶Transfer students must have a minimum of two semesters of Recital Attendance at the University of Idaho.
