## **FUN FACTS**

- » June 1940 First University of Idaho programming occurs at McCall Field Campus, Payette Lake, McCall, ID
- » Forestry Summer Camp alumni include: Dale Bosworth (former Chief of the Forest Service), Senator Jim Risch, and Dr. Philip Habib, ambassador, nominee for the Nobel Peace Prize.
- » 2001 McCall Outdoor Science School (MOSS) begins, with an initial class of 35 students attending one week program
- » MOSS is Idaho's only publicly operated K-12 outdoor school with a mission for place based, collaborative scientific inquiry within the context of Idaho's land, water and communities

## Student Numbers:

- » K-12: 2,500+ annually through MOSS program (over 40,000 students served to date)
- » Undergraduate: 125+ annually (forestry and other)
- » Graduate: 24+ annually
- Professional: 100+ Idaho teachers through education/ professional development programs
- » In 2020- 2021 MOSS collaborated with the McCall-Donnelly School District to create a local Day Program to serve students and families with programming during the COVID pandemic.
