

## Fall Prescribed Burning Activities on the UI Experimental Forest

The Experimental Forest is conducting understory burning to manage fuels and reduce impacts of future wildfires on timber and forestry research and teaching areas. Prescribed burning may contribute to occasional, short-term smoky conditions in October and November 2019, primarily in the Hatter Creek and Flat Creek drainages. A little smoke now is better than a lot of smoke later if wildfires occur during the summer months. Hunters and other recreational users: please respect closure signs during these activities to provide for your safety and ours.
