

Fall Prescribed Burning Activities on the UI Experimental Forest - 2021

The University of Idaho Experimental Forest is conducting understory burning activities in Fall 2021 to manage fuels and reduce impacts of future wildfires. Prescribed burning may contribute to occasional, short-term smoky conditions in October and November 2021, primarily in the Big Meadow, Hatter Creek and Flat Creek drainages near Harvard, Princeton and Troy. Hunters and other recreational users: please respect closure signs during these activities to provide for your safety and ours.
