Senior Thesis Project, University of Idaho

- Investigated how the American Falls Fish Hatchery impacts the surrounding area of the Snake River below the American Falls Reservoir
- Performed extensive field work on the river to collect water samples, observe fishing patterns, and track fish
- Analyzed samples and correlated data to determine relationships between the number of fish released and changes in the river
- Illustrated a map of the changes downstream from the hatchery
- Discovered a positive effect on the river ecology and fish count due to proper stewardship and care by the hatchery
