- 1. Check your Intramural Sports Handbook regarding eligibility, protests, rescheduling, etc. Living group points for Mens and Womens divisions.
- 2. An organization may enter three (3) teams to represent their living unit. However, intramural points will only be awarded to the team advancing the furthest in the tournament; other teams of an organization may enter as Independents.
- 3. The \$10.00 entry fee per team includes a can of tennis balls to be picked up at first round match by each team. One new can should be used in each match. The winner will get the unused can of tennis balls to advance to the next match.
- 4. **TEE TIME IS FORFEIT TIME!!!!**
- 5. Please read the attached forfeiture agreement, participation agreement and roster information and return with signatures to the Campus Recreation and Wellbeing Information Desk by THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 6. Check in 15 minutes before your tee time with the Intramural Supervisor.
- 7. All participants must have a waiver on file before playing Intramural Sports.

#### **Updated Protocols**


- 1. All participants wear face coverings.

### FRISBEE GOLF RULES

In the open division you may use different discs of any type and weight, for example a driver, chipper, and a putter (limit of 10 discs).

- 1. Start from tee area and throw disc at target.
- 2. At least one foot must be in contact with tee box.
- 3. Continue throwing from where the disc lands until it stays in the basket. Score 1 stroke for each throw. The object is to acquire the lowest score.
- 4. Proceed to the next tee area and repeat process.
- 5. **OUT OF BOUNDS**: A throw that lands out of bounds must be played from the point where the disc went out of bounds (one stroke penalty.)
- 6. Please WATCH OUT FOR PEDESTRIANS, VEHICLES AND BICYCLISTS ON THE ROADS AND LAWN. Try to alert people when possible of discs in flight in their direction.
- 7. Course Courtesy: Don't throw until the players ahead of you are out of range.
- 8. You are responsible for your score and one other opponent in your group, please attest scorecard.
- 9. Team scores will include 3 of the 4 players signed up.
