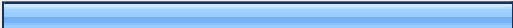

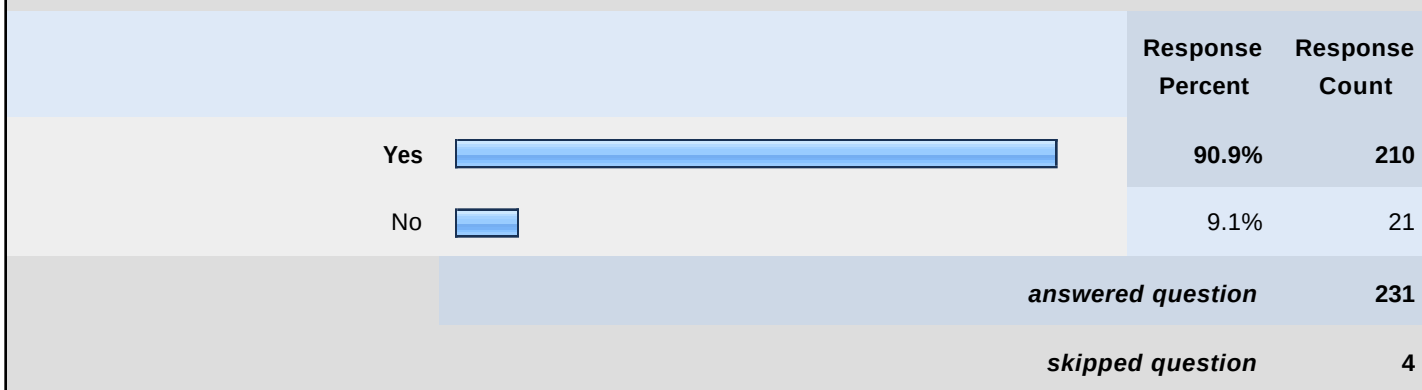

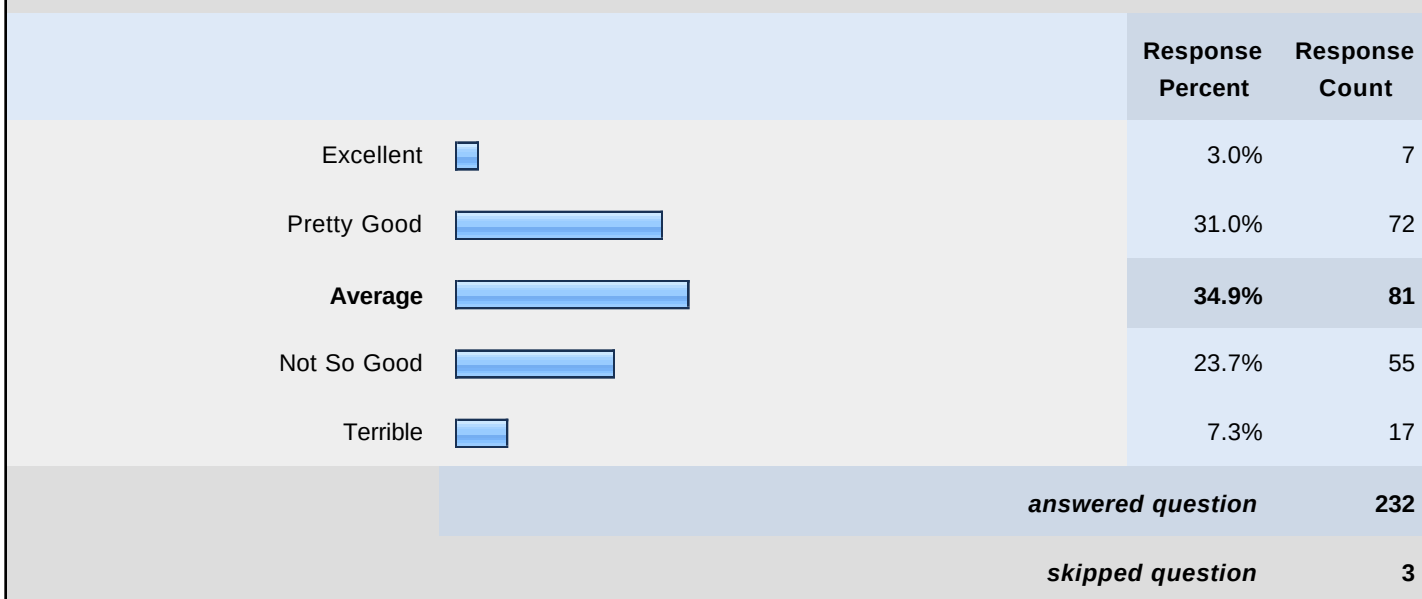

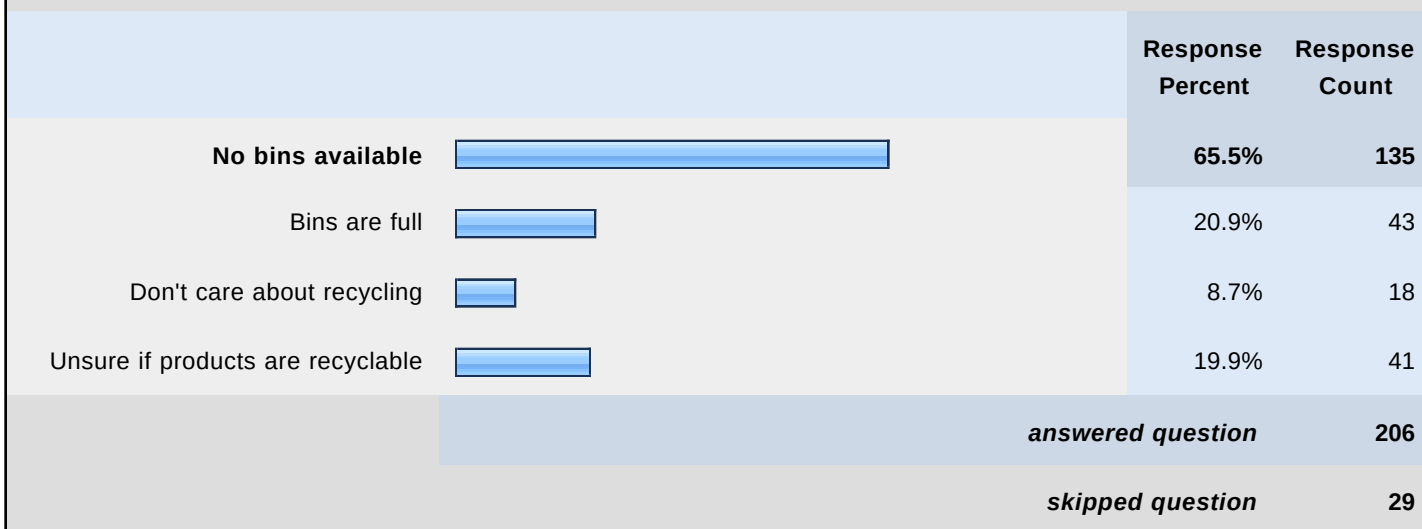
9. Do you think recycling is an important part of our campus community?
