Paid Parental Leave

Staff Council heard a presentation from the Paid Parental Leave Policy Athena Working Group and Faculty Senate Subcommittee outlining the impact and importance of paid parental leave. The presentation shared that U of I is the only 4-year state institution in Idaho not offering paid parental leave and highlighted voices of faculty and staff experiences with our current leave options. Council members had questions or clarifications about current benefits offered, and some council members spoke up about their experiences or the experiences of coworkers leaving the institution due to lack of paid parental leave. Staff Council voted unanimously in support of the concept of paid parental leave and the group moving forward to explore financial impact and feasibility at the U of I. Note: Employees seeking information about leave options should connect with the Benefits Office in Human Resources.

Staff Compensation Committee

Eric Winford, Chair of Staff Compensation Committee came to ask Council Members for feedback regarding concerns and areas to focus moving forward as the committee looks at compensation issues related to staff recruitment and retention. The committee will be meeting and a proposal(s) may be shared at the next Staff Council meeting.
