#### Overview

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#### Step 1. Contact UI Anthology Rep

Contact the UI Anthology representative to have your BbLearn account setup with a Secondary role as Faculty. The special secondary faculty role is required before you will be allowed to connect your BbLearn course with Anthology. It is required just once per user. Once your account is setup with a secondary faculty role, you may follow Step 2 (below) to connect Anthology to many of your BbLearn courses as needed.
