Step 1. Contact UI Anthology Rep

- Contact the UI Anthology representative to have your BbLearn account setup with a **Secondary role** as **Faculty**. The special *secondary faculty role* is required before you will be allowed to connect your BbLearn course with Anthology. It is required just once per user. Once your account is setup with a secondary faculty role, you may follow Step 2 (*below*) to connect *Anthology* to many of your BbLearn courses as needed.
