Dr. Scott Snyder is currently Professor of Biological Sciences at Idaho State University. He previously served for five years as ISU's Dean of the College of Science and Engineering and also served the institution as interim Vice President for Research. Prior to his time at ISU, Snyder was Chief Research Officer at the University of Nebraska Omaha for nearly eight years. Snyder earned his Ph.D. at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, where he also earned his B.S. in biology. His M.S. comes from Wake Forest University.
