



PROPOSAL DEVELOPMENT SERVICES



Level 0

Brainstorming

Strategic planning for submissions

Level 1

- Search for funding opportunities
- Training to use Pivot

Level 2

- Preparing to contact Program Officers
- Assessing "fit" of a proposed idea



Level 3

- Strategize for a resubmission
- Analyze reviews, develop responses

Level 4/5

 Ensuring proposal documents are clear, concise, cohesive, and responsive to the solicitation

Level 6

- Support for large, complex proposals
- Center grants, infrastructure, etc.




OVERVIEW OF PIVOT-RP




- In a soline database to access research funding opportunities, people, and more
- 28,000 active funding opportunities, from more than 14,000 sponsors, worth \$98 billion
 - Multi-disciplinary
 - Public and private sources: governments, foundations, corporations, non-profit organizations, etc.
 - Funding for grants, equipment, fellowships, capital improvements, travel, training, and more
- 3+ million scholar profiles to discover collaborators
- I Conferences and opportunities to present and publish your research
- 3+ million awarded grants from 45+ global funders
- Editorially curated, and updated daily


SIGN IN

 - 2. Sign in with U of I login by selecting University of Idaho from the dropdown menu





- Once you've signed in, you can claim your profile.
- Your name appears in the upper right
- Select the drop-down menu next to your name for more options



CLAIM YOUR PROFILE






Find your name in the upper right and select "Claim profile" from the drop-down menu




- Possible profiles are displayed.
- If you see the correct profile, select "This is me"
- If you have more than 1 profile (from a previous institution) select "Is your profile already claimed" and follow prompts



- If no profiles match, select "Create your profile"
- Follow the on-screen steps


