

College of Science Dean's Achievement Award

Purpose: The College of Science Dean's Achievement Award recognizes individuals for their dedication, service, and support of the College of Science and/or extraordinary leadership and service to the state of Idaho and beyond.

Nature of Recognition: The award normally will be presented in conjunction with the fall College of Science Advisory Board meeting. It will consist of a plaque presented to the recipient and addition of the recipient's name to a plaque in the dean's office. There normally will be a limit of two awardees per year, but the dean may elect to increase the number of awardees in any given year if necessary.

Selection: The Dean of the College of Science will make the selection of the recipients.

Criteria:

- Open to any living person who has contributed extraordinary service and support to the College of Science and/or the state and beyond.
- It is not required that the recipient be a graduate of the college.

Nominations: Nominations for current year awards are due June 1; however, nominations will be accepted throughout the year. Nominations received after June 1 will be held for the following year. Nominations should include a nomination letter (limit 2 pages including full name, title, contact information for nominee, as well as a description detailing the nominee's achievements as they relate to the criteria above), two or three letters of support, and a brief curriculum vitae or resume (limit 5 pages). Nominations will be accepted from faculty and staff, alumni, friends, and CoS Advisory Board members.
