### **GETTING STARTED:**

- VISAS Admission to the ALCP program qualifies students for either F-1 (student) status or J-1 (exchange visitor) status. An international student advisor is available for counseling on immigration and other matters.
- HEALTH INSURANCE All students must have health insurance. Students can buy a University of Idaho student insurance plan after arriving in Idaho or purchase a comparable plan in their home countries. Contact us to send documents to receive a waiver.
- SPECIAL PROGRAMS ALCP can create special programs for special groups. If you have a group you would like us to create a program for, contact us.

### WHAT TO EXPECT:

- 16-week fall and spring sessions and a 10-week summer session each year.
- Hours per week: 18 hours per week (Monday-Friday) of integrated language instruction, including reading, writing, listening, speaking, and grammar.
- Three levels: elementary, intermediate, and advanced.
- Part-time option depending on VISA type.
