Eligibility Requirements and Preferences:

- Applicants must be enrolled full-time and be in good academic standing at the University of Idaho with a major in the College of Letters, Arts and Social Sciences.
- Applicants must have a cumulative institutional GPA of 3.0 to be eligible for the Poe Scholarship.
- Applicants must be a resident of the State of Idaho for the Sullivan and Ware Scholarships.
- Applicants must have junior or senior standing to be eligible for the Sullivan Scholarship.
- Preference is given to applicants from Lewiston, Idaho; or members of the Delta Tau Delta Fraternity for the Ware Scholarship.
- Preference will be given to applicants who have junior or senior standing for the Poe Scholarship.
- Preference will be given to applicants with an interest in Volunteerism/Community Service for the McCullough Scholarship.
- Financial need is a secondary consideration.
