Submission Procedures:

- Word count: 750-3000
- Any Citations are in a standard format, Ex. Chicago, MLA, etc. (only if applicable)
- Strongly suggest footnotes or end notes
- Double spaced
- Acceptable Fonts: Times New Roman
- Font size: 12
- Papers will be peer-reviewed anonymously (submit manuscripts with a title page

including affiliation, email, and title. Please remove any identifiers from the main text of the paper that would suggest its author.)
