III. Old Business

- a. Limit on Directed Study credits as discussed in the last meeting: No more than three credits of workshop or workshop equivalent courses and no more than nine credits of directed study (499/502) may be used toward the graduate degree. (This would be in the master's degree section of COGS general requirements and connected to the current language about workshops. <u>Master's Degrees < University of Idaho (uidaho.edu)</u> The council would like to take it back to fellow faculty for more feedback and discussion.
- b. Graduate Admissions proposals in last meeting: Statement of Purpose for nonthesis/professional programs to question format. Discussion and feedback.
 Letter of recommendation format and/or number required for professional programs. No vote, yet. The council will discuss it later; this is still under consideration.

IV. New Business

- a. Curriculum items: MS in Geography, MS GIS, and Grad Certificate in Climate Change (attached course leaf items) Alistair Smith available for questions, if needed., and INTR 509 Applied Data Science and MSAT course change. Approved. (Vote 8 Yes, 1 Abstention)
- b. Graduate Admissions Proposals: Duolingo Test of English: Proposal to accept the Duolingo for one additional year on a temporary basis Duolingo has sufficient data to reassess the English proficiency concordance with TOEFL and IELTS. Their updated proposal for TOEFL 79 equivalency is Duolingo 115. Revisit later.
- c. Conditional Admission: the name must be removed from the catalog as the U of I is not currently approved to issue I-20s for intensive English pathways. We can still admit students with pending English proficiency (selected programs) but we may no longer use the term "conditional admission".
