CLERY ACT

The Clery Act is a consumer protection law that aims to provide transparency around campus crime policy and statistics by requiring each University or College to publish an Annual Security Report that details campus policies and statistics of campus crime for the preceding 3 years. You must disclose statistics for reported Clery Act crimes that occur on campus, on public property within or immediately adjacent to campus, and in or on non-campus buildings or property that your institution owns or controls.


