	Complete 5 Poultry Lesson Plan activities. Record each activity completed in the 4-H Animal Record Book, Project Information and Activity Log.
	Provide appropriate documentation, which includes a bill of sale and a COOL (Country of Origin Labeling) document to meet the federal requirements of COOL. Check with local Extension Office for exact forms required and the deadline for turning in those forms.
	Complete the 4-H Project Record Book for this project in your ZSuite Member Account
	Fill out your 4-H Involvement Report in your ZSuite Member Account
	Give an oral presentation (speech, demonstration, or illustrated talk) to your 4-H peers on a topic related to this project.
