FALL ENROLLMENT ANNOUNCEMENT!

Latah County will open enrollment for the new 4-H year in ZSuite beginning **October 15.** If you are already have a ZSuite account, please <u>do not</u> create a new account. Enrollment will happen through your existing family account.

Enrollment is not considered COMPLETE until your dues are paid via check, cash, or credit card:

General Members: \$25 Leaders: \$5 Horse Members: \$30 Family Cap (3+ members): \$75

Pay online: Latah County has an online payment platform! You can pay dues here: <u>http://tinyurl.com/Latah4HEnrollment</u>. The credit card processing fee is 3%+\$1 or you can opt to pay via e-check with a \$1 fee.

Deadline: Latah County 4-H enrollment (ZSuite submitted & dues paid) will be due March 31 in order to have a project at the Latah County Fair.

Annual club financial reports are due by <u>October 15</u>. This is a process completed annually and is required if clubs are to remain in good standing and enroll members each year. Completed packets can be emailed to jvanburen@uidaho.edu or turned in to the Extension Office.

Club leaders need to complete the following documents (<u>4-H Documents &</u> <u>Forms - UI Extension in Latah County (uidaho.edu</u>):

- 1. Annual Financial Summary
- 2. Annual Financial Audit Committee Certification
- 3. Financial Audit Form Checklist
- 4. Civil Rights Engagement Report

PLUS - a copy of your club's most recent bank statement.


