## *Latah County Master Gardener's Recommend...*

**Common Lilac** | *Syringa vulgaris*  
Cut flowers, hedge, fragrance

**Red Osier Dogwood** | *Cornus stolonifera*  
Winter color, hedge

**Oregon Grape** | *Mahonia aquifolium*  
Berries, fragrance

**Viburnum** | *Viburnum vibernum*  
Wide variety of shapes, sizes, flowers

**Serviceberry** | *Amelanchier alnifolia*  
Bird habitat, native, easy to grow

**Spirea** | *Spirea spirea*  
Wide variety of shares, sizes, flowers

**Forsythia** | *Forsythia intermedia*  
Spring flower, low maintenance

**Cotoneaster** | *Cotoneaster contoneaster*  
Low growing, sprawling, berries

**Vine Maple** | *Acer circinatum*  
Fall color, easy to grow, native

**Euonymus** | *Euonymus euonymus*  
Interesting leaf color, spring through fall
