Over 2,000 Idaho loggers have taken the 3-day University of Idaho Extension program on forest ecology, silviculture, and water quality titled *Logger Education to Advance Professionalism* or “LEAP”. Flyers for 2024 LEAP sessions (April 23-25, 2024 in Moscow and April 30-May 2, 2024 in Post Falls) will be available at your local UI Extension office or at www.uidaho.edu/extension/forestry.

LEAP Update is an annual opportunity for loggers to build on LEAP with in-depth training on forestry topics. The program also helps loggers meet Idaho Pro-Logger BMP training and continuing education requirements.
