




-  **GOLD LOTS:** Gold or Visitor permits only. **Enforced 6 a.m. to 5 p.m., M - F, year round. Gold or Overnight permit required between 2 - 6 a.m.**
-  **GREEN LOTS:** Green or Visitor permits only. **Enforced 24 hours/day, year-round.**
-  Permit not required for **DAYTIME** parking in regular spaces during Summer Break. No parking between 2 - 6 a.m.
-  Permit not required for **DAYTIME OR OVERNIGHT (2 - 6 a.m.)** parking in regular spaces of Purple and Silver off-street parking lots during Summer Break. No vehicle storage.
-  **LONG-TERM VEHICLE STORAGE** Vehicles may park in these lots 24 hours/day during Summer Break. Vehicles parked long-term **MUST** be moved prior to regular enforcement resuming the first day of fall semester.
-  **PAY-TO-PARK:** 6 a.m. to 9 p.m., M - F, year round. No overnight parking.
-  **MANAGED PARKING:** Special permit required; includes but not limited to ADA parking.
-  **PEDESTRIAN MALL:** Parking with special permit allowed in designated spaces only. No overnight parking.
-  **MOTORCYCLE SPACES:** Motorcycle parking only. No permit required.
-  **SMART TRANSIT BUS STOPS:** There are eight SMART Transit stops located on campus. SMART Transit fixed-route buses are **FREE** for students and the entire Moscow community. Visit www.smarttransit.org for more information.
