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# **The Problem**

#### Harmful

Economic and social strain on families, racially discriminatory in practice, prevents rehabilitation and increases recidivism

### Unlawful

Sometimes practices and policies run contrary to state and federal law (See Beck v. Elmore County Magistrate *Court*)

#### Costly

Minimal revenue or loss of revenue, especially when balanced against time and resources spent on collection

#### **Evaluations Report**

In 2015, Idaho courts ordered \$65 million in fines and fees in criminal cases. 21% of cases in OPE's sample had not seen a single payment, and "the gap between the amount ordered and the amount collected has increased from 2001-2015."


