13 IDAHO TREASURE AWARD

Recognizes living retired University of Idaho faculty, staff and family members who, in their retirement years, have made significant achievements in service or leadership to the university. Managed by UI Retirees Association. *Nomination deadline is April 1.*

AWARDS PROGRAM PROTOCOL

- The Alumni Association directors and the Alumni Relations office staff facilitate the alumni award process and do not nominate candidates or advocate for nominees.
- The University of Idaho desires to promote and encourage diversity in all campus areas including employment, student recruitment and the alumni awards process.
- The University of Idaho Alumni Association Awards Committee reserves the right to move candidates and their nomination to other alumni award categories.
- The University of Idaho Alumni Association Awards Committee exercises sole discretion in the review of nominations and selection of alumni award recipients.
- The University of Idaho, for the award program purposes, currently defines "alumni status" as those with a University of Idaho degree, or 90+ University of Idaho credits. This also includes the recipients of the University of Idaho honorary degrees and honorary University of Idaho alumni within eligibility for "alumni status" awards.
- All awards nominations and the nominee review process shall be confidential.

The Alumni Awards program began in 1962 and serves as the Alumni Association mechanism to directly recognize and reward deserving University of Idaho alumni, volunteers and other individuals.
