



O.M. Plummer Scholarship Application Process

The O.M. Plummer Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in memory of the late O.M. Plummer in recognition of his outstanding efforts on behalf of the 4-H Club Program and of the Pacific International Livestock Exposition. The Oregon Community Foundation is the trustee of this scholarship fund. Each year one outstanding 4-H livestock member from Idaho, who has participated in livestock showing or judging beyond the county level, will be awarded a scholarship to assist the winner in attending a college of his or her choice. In keeping with the original intent of the scholarship to be used for members who had participated in the PI, those eligible to receive this scholarship must have participated in beef, sheep, swine, dairy, or goat projects. Please note: Horse and small animal projects are not eligible to receive this scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Must have participated in livestock showing or judging beyond the county level (i.e., district, area, state, regional, national shows and contests).
2. Must be a member of a 4-H livestock club and have taken livestock projects for at least 3 years.
3. Must be a senior in high school.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Complete O.M. Plummer Memorial Scholarship Online Application (follow instructions below).
2. Upload Achievement Story.
3. Upload high school transcript.
4. Upload current head and shoulders photograph.

RULES FOR PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

1. Award to be paid directly to the school attended by the recipient.
2. If the nominee has not yet selected a college, nominee must notify Oregon Community Foundation of his or her choice by August 1.

DUE DATE: Applications must be completed through 4-H Online by February 1, 2015.



HOW TO APPLY THROUGH 4-H ONLINE: You must be enrolled and in active status in 4-H for the 2015 program year to apply.

To apply, follow these steps:

1. Log on to 4-H Online at <https://idaho.4honline.com>
2. Complete your re-enrollment for 2015 and pay your county's enrollment fee.
3. After a county 4-H staff member has approved your enrollment and your status is "active", you may begin the application process.
4. Log on to 4-H Online at: <https://idaho.4honline.com>. Select "Continue to Family".





5. Select "Register Member for an Event". Select your name. Select O.M. Plummer Scholarship.

If your enrollment status is inactive or incomplete, click the Edit button to review, update (or correct) and submit your report for approval. If your status is Pending, your record is complete and waiting for county Extension approval.

Volunteers must have a successful background screen, completed the Protecting Minors Training, and remit enrollment fees (to county Extension Office) for an enrollment to be considered complete.
