2017-2018 Verification of High School Completion Status

This form is for informational purposes and is not required to be returned to the University of Idaho. However - please provide one of the following documents to indicate your high school completion status when you begin college in 2017–2018:

If you are a high school student and have not yet completed your final year of high school, please submit your required documentation once you are able to do so.

- A copy of your high school diploma.
- A copy of your final official high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.
- If you completed secondary education in a foreign country, a copy of the “secondary school leaving certificate” or other similar document.
- A state certificate or transcript received after you passed a State-authorized examination that the State recognizes as the equivalent of a high school diploma (i.e. GED test, HiSET, TASC, or other State-authorized examination).
- An academic transcript that indicates you successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor’s degree.
- If you were homeschooled in a state where state law requires you to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a copy of that credential.
- If you were homeschooled in a state where state law does not require you to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript, or the equivalent, signed and dated by your parent or guardian, as certification that you successfully completed a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.
