• Animals brought to fair <u>must</u> be on your entry form, you may enter all animals from initial weigh in, but <u>only</u> bring 2 to fair.

• Animals not meeting weight requirements will not sell. But can be shown in the feeder class

Note: Each exhibitor can sell only one (1) market animal of any market species.

• Animals who do not make minimum weights may be taken home the night of entry.

• ** Swine weighing between 301-320 will only be allowed to sell if the sale committee can find a buyer for these heavy weight swine.
