Animal B: Steer B weighed 1250 lbs live and has a 775 lbs carcass. This steer has a quality grade of Choice and is a yield grade 2.

Quality and Yield grade:
Choice $1=1.34 / \mathrm{lb}$
Choice $2=1.28 / \mathrm{lb}$
Choice $3=1.28 / \mathrm{lb}$
Choice $4=1.08 / \mathrm{lb}$

Select $1=1.19 / \mathrm{lb}$
Select 2 = 1.13/lb
Select 3 = 1.13/lb
Select $4=.93 / \mathrm{lb}$
