COOL Law became mandatory September 30, 2008. 4-H & FFA market livestock (sheep and goat) projects must provide information to document animal origin to buyers. All projects should also maintain a record of animal (s) sold one year from the date of sale. This information must be completed and turned in at the time of the initial weigh-in. You must provide one form per animal. As an affidavit is deemed by USDA as an official record of Country of Origin, I attest through first-hand knowledge, normal business records, or producer affidavit (s) that all livestock referenced by the "Bill of Sale" are of Origin. (list country in space, exampleUSA) By signing below the buyer and seller certify that the information contained on this document is true and correct to the best of their knowledge. If any of the information is found to be purposefully mis-leading or incorrect the buyer will be barred from participation in any Madison County 4-H/FFA contest or sale that said information would affect.
