	Complete a Non-Animal Record Book.	Submit via ZSuite before Fair.		
	Submit Fair entries.	Entries are open June 15-July 15. Entries are required to exhibit at Fair. Late entries will not be accepted.		
	Complete this Checklist and submit to your leader before Fair.	Must be signed by member, parent, and leader to be considered complete.		
	Choose a handcraft area and set goals.	Choose one traditional handcraft area and set at least three goals. Members are not limited to the specific areas listed in the manual. Selected Area: _____		
	Learn and develop skills to complete goals.	Learn and develop skills necessary to complete goals and the area unit through research or instruction from a person in your community who has said area skills.		
	Write a history of the selected handwork area.	Write a history of the handwork area you have selected. Include when and where the handwork originated, what it was used for, and how and when it came to the United States. Be sure to cite your sources.
